Churches have had to be kept closed through lockdown, but limited, safe re-opening is now allowed. St Giles' church will be open for private prayer on Wednesdays from 15 June: 8:00 until 9:00 am and 5:00 until 6:00pm. There is important guidance in the church to help with seating and keeping safe.
